A Professional Services Agreement (PSA) was signed between the Community Cancer Center (CCC) in Roseburg, OR and Oregon Health & Science University's (OHSU) Department of Radiation Oncology to provide radiation oncology physician services beginning on January 1, 2020.

CCC's well respected oncologists, Drs. Randy Moore and Sylvia Gosline will join the OHSU Department of Radiation Oncology staff while continuing their practice at CCC. OHSU is actively recruiting a third physician who will become CCC's new Medical Director of Radiation Oncology. The new Medical Director will reside in Roseburg and be an active member of our community.
